

Uniform Care Quick Reference Guide

BAND

Jacket



Drape



Overcoat

DRY CLEAN ONLY

At pick up take a minute to go over the entire uniform. Make sure the white is white and all spots are off of the drape and pants. Have cleaned, again, if necessary, and require a RUSH. When home, allow uniform to hang to reduce wrinkles and air out.

DO NOT DRY CLEAN

From the manufacturer:
Machine wash warm.
Tumble dry low.
DO NOT: dry clean, bleach or iron.

<p style="text-align: center;">Jacket Collar</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Wash Regularly DO NOT Dry Clean Unsnap from Jacket and wash with whites. Bleach when necessary.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Dinkles</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">From the manufacturer: Clean with soap and water or diluted leather cleaners with soft cloth. A shine can be put back on the leather with a car care product such as Armorall® or Armorall® wipes. If the shoe is scuffed through the finish, only polish the scratched area with the coordinating color.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Hanger</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Do NOT take to dry cleaner. Always store uniform on WTMB hanger.</p>
